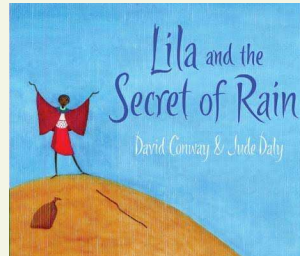

sentences with exclamation marks

Exclamations are used to show intense feelings or to get attention.

Lila's Kenyan village was suffering a terrible drought!

sentences with subordinating conjunctions

Examples of subordinating conjunctions are:
when, because, if

The crops failed *because* there was no rain.

words with apostrophes for contractions

In a contraction, an apostrophe represents missing letters.

are not = *aren't*
they are = *they're*
have not = *haven't*
she will = *she'll*

Non-Chronological Reports should...

- use a title,
- have an introduction,
- have information organised into sections,
- have a sub-heading for each section,
- use facts that you have researched,
- include pictures with captions.
