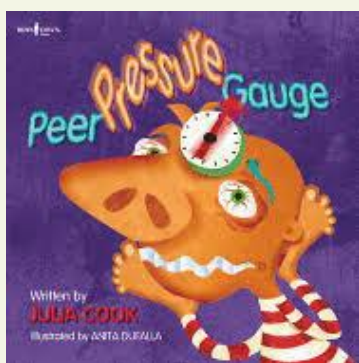

I know I am individual, unique and when I achieve something, I feel proud.

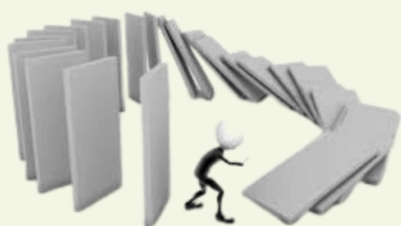


Choices



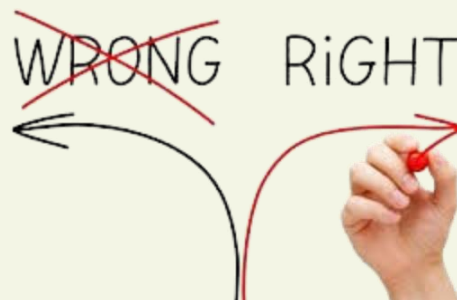
I need to make the right choices to make sure I do the right thing.
